**NOTE: Meeting on SEP25 begins EARLY at 6:30 so arrive early!**

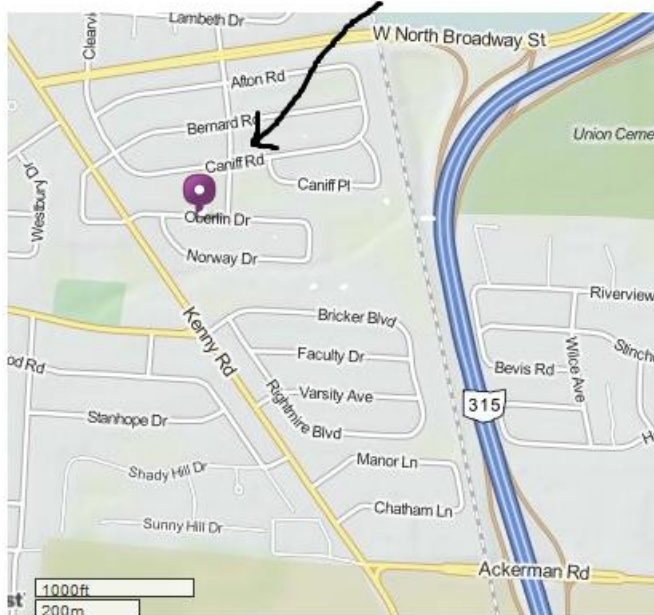


We now meet at the Harrison House, located at 570 West Broad Street, Corner of Broad and Gift Streets. Park your car in the lot just west of Harrison House.
