Since Covid has prevented face-to-face meetings for so long, we had a LOT of business to handle. Work is progressing on Colopex, which is fast approaching. Club officers and members had gathered auction lots and brought many of them for sale. The auction raised \$57 dollars for the club. The business meeting lasted
